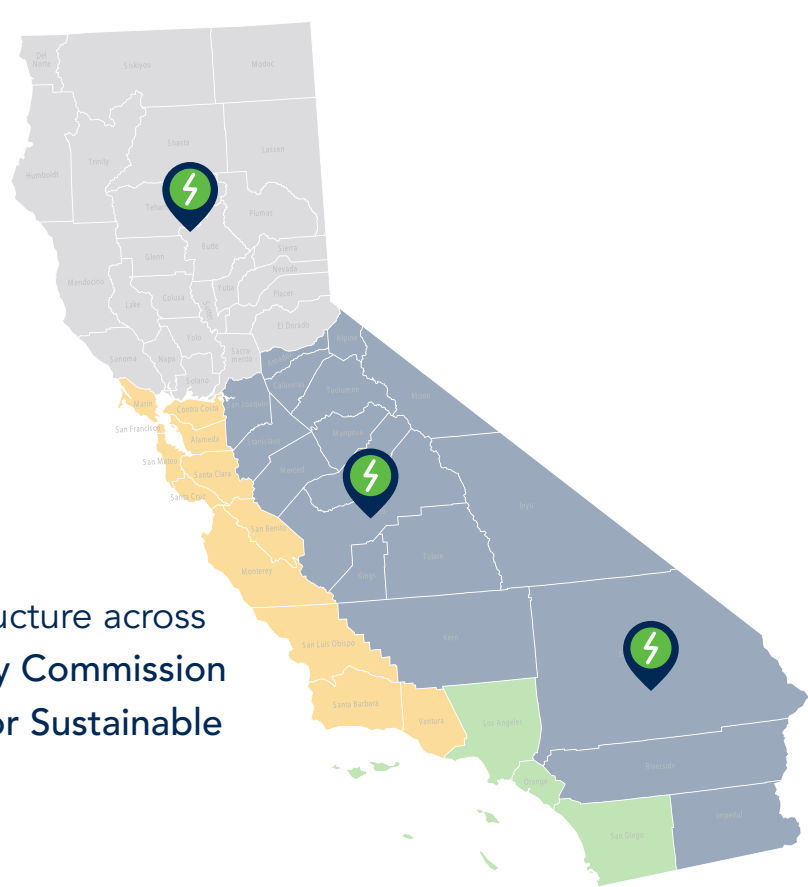
If you are located in the state of California, you maybe be eligible to receive substantial rebates for publicly available EV Chargers at your location to support the movement towards sustainable energy.

# \$55 Million

in funding to expand EV charging infrastructure across California funded by the California Energy Commission (CEC), and implemented by the Center for Sustainable Energy (CSE).

## Key Funding Details

- At Least \$55 Million statewide
- Application window July 8th, 2025-September 30th, 2025
- Open to all regions in California
- \$55K per port for chargers 150 kW-274.99 kW
- \$100K per port for chargers with 275 kW+ output
- Funding is first come, first served

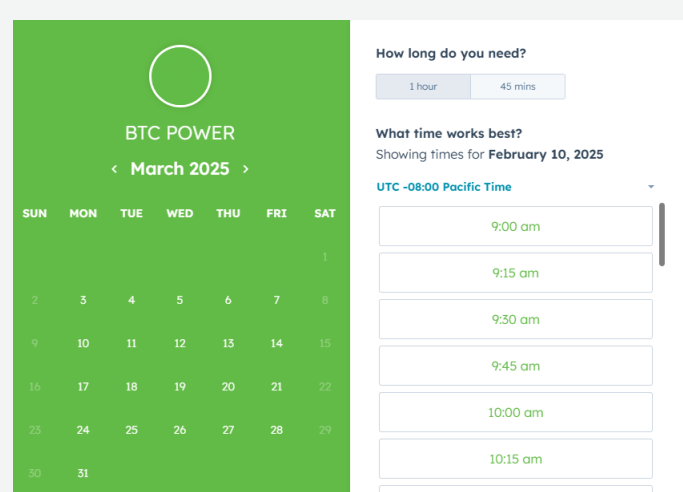


## Eligible Installation Sites & Equipment Requirements

- Publicly Accessible 24/7** With the exception of parking garages
- Must be on paved services** No new construction sites
- NEW DC Fast Chargers** at least 150 kW output per port
- Must Use CCS connectors**
- ENERGY STAR certified** and OCPP 2.0.1 compliant
